

# Rules for Activists

Here are some "Rules of Thumb" for Activists

You may feel free to mail the flyer to your friends and family. That is a good place to start.

If you want to go door to door in a neighborhood, please remember these points; 1] Always be polite and respectful. 2] Do not cross a lawn, but use the walkway instead. 3] Go directly to the door. 4] If you put the flier between the doors or in the door jam, please make sure the door is completely closed and secure. 5] Exit the way that you came in and move on to the next house. 6] Never argue with a home owner. If they do not want you there, respectfully give your apologies and leave immediately.

Never deliver to; Government buildings, stores, malls, hospitals, apartment complexes, condos or homes that have a No Soliciting sign or to any back door. Only deliver to private homes.

If you want to put them under the windshield wipers of cars, please remember the following; 1] Never rub a belt buckle, jean stud or zipper against the car body. That will do damage that you will be responsible for. 2] Carefully lift the wiper only as high as it takes to slip the flier under it. 3] Always put it on the drivers side, for their convenience. 4] If you can not put it under the wiper, fold it and put it into the door jam of the drivers side door so that they can clearly see it.

Never deliver to cars; 1] Parked in a parking garage, 2] On private property, 3] In a parking lot of any kind, 4] Or parked at any of the building locations you can not deliver to. Only vehicles parked in public areas on public streets are permissible.

Remember, always be kind, respectful, and show care in the performance of your activities. Do unto others what you would have them do unto you. We all like to be treated with respect, so pass that along to others.
